A-LEVEL PROGRAMME FRENCH

Now that you know that it's very useful to have a modern foreign language like French under your belt, let's have a look at the A-level programme:

The 2-year course will cover **4 topics**, an **independent research project** (IRP) as well as a <u>film</u> * and a <u>book</u> * to be studied before the students sit their final Edexcel exam (-2 written papers and one oral exam-) at the end of the second year.

As you are considering joining French A-levels, let's first concentrate on the 2 topics you can expect to study in the *FIRST* year within our dynamic department:

- Les festivals et les traditions







A-LEVEL PROGRAMME FRENCH
